#### Dear supporters,

2021 was a year of active mobilization for our association in developing a more sustainable and social agriculture. Over 40 years after the creation of SOL, we are more than ever committed to revalorizing the role of farmers and to preserving natural resources thanks to the development of farming agroecology.

We are proud of what has been achieved alongside with our local partners, financial partners, donors, employees, volunteers, networks and supporters.

Now that agricultural and food stakes are at the centre of attention, our actions have a greater relevance. They represent fertile solutions of collective actions in 4 continents on 4 main goals :

- Building sustainable agricultural and food systems
- Preserving cultivated biodiversity
- Promoting agroecological and farming transition
- ✓ Integrating farming agroecology in public policies

Alongside with 35 partners, we lead 14 projects in India, France, Peru and West Africa to cultivate new systems, that are more respectful of the people and resources of our planet.

2021 has allowed us to meet again with our partners and supporters to exchange about agricultural and food transition, and especially about the essential transmission of know-hows, both locally in France and internationally. This represents a necessary action to support the installation of new farmers and to encourage a sustainable agroecological and farming agroecology. Also, our projects could not be held without the commitment of our working team of 10 people and the creation of an advocacy position to carry on with providing information to a large public and calling for a change of policy making.

### SUMMARY OF THE YEAR 2021



#### **PASSERELLES PAYSANNES - FRANCE**

Defend the diversity of experiences and develop the synergies between the operators of new farmers installation, to create employment and promote knowhows transmission, especially with the development of farming mentoring.

#### SMALL FARMS – SENEGAL

Experiment and create a model of school farming and agroecological production as a driving force to achieve food sovereignty, rural employment, environment protection and solidarity in Sahel.

#### SEEDS OF RESILIENCE – INDIA

Ensure food security to farming communities at a local and regional scale, by reinforcing their resilience to ecological, sanitary and socioeconomical crises via agroecology and preservation of farmer seeds.

#### MAISON DES SEMENCES PAYSANNES MARALPINES – FRANCE

Set farmer seeds at the centre of agricultural and food models to ensure sustainable and healthy systems for everyone in the Alpes Maritimes, with the mobilisation of a large scale of actors, from farmers to consumers.

#### **BIOCACAO – PERU**

Support agroforestry and biodiversity preservation to promote a sustainable production of cacao and to reduce the harmful effects of climate changes in the Amazonian region of Ucayali.

#### **PROMOTION OF TRADITIONAL CEREALS – SENEGAL**

Develop a sustainable local cereal sector - from producers to consumers - that allow the reinforcement of food sovereignty thanks to the valorisation of local production and consumption and the creation of employment in rural areas. 10 years of actions in India for women and agroecological transition

#### DETAILS ON EMPLOYMENT AND RESOURCES IN 2021

We saw in 2021 the emergence of two new transversal programs on peasant agroecology and food sovereignty in West Africa. 78% of our resources come from private subsidies, 10% from public subsidies and consultancy services, and 13% from donations (both rising). It allows us to perform 49% of our actions worldwide, 33% in France and 13% dedicated to awareness-raising activities.

### **DETAILS ABOUR THE 2021 BALANCE**

Despite the persistent difficulties due to the sanitary crisis, we were able alongside with our generous donors and helpful partners to realise a positive balance of 5 528€. We also benefited from the help of numerous volunteers who support our projects on the field and our actions of communication, awareness raising actions and promotion.
