Please give one suggestion for how to improve the format / organisation of these meetings?

I suggest that DG trade, DG Agri and DG Devco should consult more in depth the representatives of EU NGOs as most of the time the Commission CSOs meetings are mainly attended by representatives of European businesses whose first objective is to export more without any concern on the impact of their increased exports on the EU capacity to comply with its commitments on SDGs and climate change and on PCD. And more in-depth consultation with the EU NGOs is all the more necessary that African NGOs are hardly consulted by their governments.

I appreciate the high degree of openness of the representatives of the three DGs in this meeting but at the same time the high degree of their ignorance, excuse me for my frank language, of the issues which were on the agenda, particularly he AfCFTA, the TFRA an the EPAs. It would suggest that the representatives of the three DG would agree to consult us, including by e-mails, in a more direct way, voluntarily and free of charges for the Commission, than through formal experts consultations implying expenses for the Commission budget.
