Operating on four continents, we are determined to respond to key structural needs: the construction of sustainable agricultural and food systems, the preservation of cultivated biodiversity, the agroecological transition, and the integration of agroecology into public policies.

To achieve this, one of our hallmarks is the diversity of our action levers.



SOL IN ACTION: 17 PROJECTS, 42 PARTNERS, 4 CONTINENTS.

PASSERELLES PAYSANNES - FRANCE -

To promote and defend the diversity of career paths and the synergies between the actors involved in setting up a farm, a source of employment and a mean of passing on farming know-how, especially developing farmer mentoring. Over 20,000 users a year have access to information to help them set up in farming.

SMALL FARMS - SENEGAL -

Experiment and create a model of farming school and agroecological production as a driving force to achieve food sovereignty, rural employment, environment protection and solidarity in Sahel. 750 pupils in the area are familiar with the basic principles of agroecology.

SEEDS OF RESILIENCE - INDIA -

Ensure food security to farming communities at a local and regional scale, by reinforcing their resilience to ecological, sanitary and socioeconomical crises via agroecology and preservation of farmer seeds. This project benefits 4,000 supported farmers' families. 16,000 people are indirect beneficiaries.

HOUSE OF MARALPINES FARMER SEEDS - FRANCE -

Set farmer seeds at the center of agricultural and food models to ensure sustainable and healthy systems for everyone in the Alpes Maritimes, with the mobilization of a large scale of actors, from farmers to consumers.

BIOCACAO

- PERU -

Support agroforestry and biodiversity preservation to promote a sustainable production of cacao and to reduce the harmful effects of climate changes in the Amazonian region of Ucayali.

VALORISATION OF LOCAL CEREALS - SÉNÉGAL -

Develop a sustainable local cereal sector (from producers to consumers) that allow the reinforcement of food sovereignty thanks to the valorization of local production and consumption and the creation of employment in rural areas. 42,000 consumers in 80 villages are the indirect beneficiaries of this project.

TANDEMS SOLIDAIRES - FRANCE -

Raising awareness among school students in the Occitanie Region on the challenges of rural agroecology and international solidarity. 65 students were involved in 2022.



Details on employment and resources in 2022

The year 2022 saw the launch of three projects involving the training of trainers on endogenous knowledge of agroecology in West Africa, farmer exchanges in France and raising awareness through comic book exhibitions. Two projects were renewed, one focusing on small farmers' agroecology and food sovereignty in West Africa and the other on education for citizenship and international solidarity in France. 64% of our resources come from private subsidies, 19% from skills sponsorship and consultancy services and 14% from public subsidies. These resources enable us to carry out our activities, of which 52% of expenditure supports our international activities, 23% our activities in France (development of the center) and 12% our awareness-raising and advocacy activities.

Details about the 2022 balance

Thanks to an increase in the provision of services and the maintenance of the rest of the business, we were able to achieve a positive result of €10,205. The costs incurred by the structure remain limited. A provision for risks of €2,800 was made, due to a possible reduction in the subsidy for a farmers' exchange project in West Africa following the cancellation of a meeting by our partners. The HR team was strengthened again this year to meet the needs of the business.

The accounts for the 2022 financial year were drawn up by Finacoop the association's-chartered accountant, and certified by Doucet, Beth and Associates.
